DESCRIPTION	100% Group instructed and includes a 15-minute group lesson with a professional coach.	75% Group instructed, 25% independent personal development time and includes a 15-minute group lesson with a professional coach. Solo and element competitions are optional.	50% Group instructed, 50% independent personal development time and includes a 15-minute group lesson with a professional coach. Solo is mandatory and we encourage skaters at this level to participate in local competitions. Must skate a minimum of 2 days/week.
All sessions are supervised by Professional Coaches and Program Assistants. CSA approved helmets are mandatory up to stage 5 (discretion of the coaches to determine when the skater is ready to remove the helmet). Figure skates are mandatory on these sessions. Solo and competitions are an additional cost.
